“Wide Angle” Wraps Up Its Second Season

One of ACMi's most talked-about series, “Wide Angle” with Peter Bermudes, is closing its second jam-packed season with an episode that focuses on the kind of compelling, complicated issue it is known for tackling – does a democratic society have a vested interest in ensuring that all its citizens receive a basic income? Peter is joined in the studio by Michael Howard, professor of Philosophy at the University of Maine and the coordinator of the US Basic Income Guarantee Network, to discuss the wisdom of having a populace that is free from worry about food and rent, and therefore fully available to the work of remaining informed and politically engaged. In response to age-old debates about such questions, one enduring idea has been that of a government-ensured payment – with different timeframes, amounts, and criteria, depending on the specific proposal. Now perhaps more than ever, these are timely issues to unpack, and Peter and his guest, as always, do so in a clear and engaging way that will leave the viewer better informed by show's end. It's on the Public channel in its regular timeslot – Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays at 7 pm.
