Do a Double Take
In the spirit of The Moth Radio Hour and other storytelling events, some months back the Arlington Human Rights Commission invited the community to take part in Double Take. A number of Arlington residents recounted incidents, episodes, and experiences from their own lives for an audience of hundreds in attendance. As you might imagine, their stories ran quite the gamut, both in subject matter and tone – from lightly comic to powerfully poignant – and those assembled were amused, moved, stimulated, and heartened. At least two things were clear to one and all: storytelling is indeed a powerful art, and there is a real hunger in our town for more of it. You can see (and hear) for yourself, now that Double Take is making its debut on our Public channel. Enjoy!

Wide Angle Begins its Fourth (!) Season
It's with genuine excitement that we announce the return of our flagship general-interest interview series, Wide Angle. Over their first three years, host Peter Bermudes and his co-producer Lee Urton have created a vibrant platform for the deep exploration of dozens of vexing, complicated issues, and their quest continues. It seems fitting that the debut episode of the new season focuses on one of the oldest paradigms of human behavior. Evolutionary theory itself tends to amplify humans' competitive tendencies over our cooperative behaviors. But what if that idea... is just plain wrong? How different might our lives be if we led with our collaborative, community-building skills rather than conceiving of our basic nature as greedy and selfish? Peter and his guest, British author Jeremy Lent, explore humanity's path from its hunter-gatherer origins to our current challenge with climate change. It is, as always, TV that challenges and informs, and it airs on the Public channel several times per week.

In the Tradition Welcomes a Pair of Blues Legends
For 25 years Paul Rishell & Annie Raines have been hailed as one of the world's best blues duos. Their six albums include Moving to the Country (2000), winner of that year's W.C. Handy Award for Acoustic Blues Record of the Year. They've opened for the likes of Ray Charles and Little Feat; performed and recorded with Susan Tedeschi, John Sebastian, and Rory Block; and guested on Late Night with Conan O'Brien. They continue to perform American roots music and their own compositions at festivals, concert halls, and clubs all over the world. So it is with quite a resume that the duo pulls into ACMI's Studio A for a session on In the Tradition, sharing stories from a remarkable career and jamming with host Alan Kaufman. It's another stellar episode of ACMI's iconic traditional music series – look for this latest In the Tradition in its usual weekly time slots on our Public channel.
