Criminal Justice Reform Series Shines a Light
Criminal Justice Reform is coming to Massachusetts. Massive bills on the subject have proceeded through both chambers at the State House, and the work of reconciling the two into a single omnibus bill is going on right now. Did you know that a small but committed group based in Arlington, as one legislator put it, has "their fingerprints all over the legislation?" The Mass Incarceration Working Group (MIWG) of First Parish Church in Arlington Center has done a prodigious amount of work on this matter over their 5-year history, and they have been instrumental in ACMI's public affairs series entitled "Criminal Justice Reform." In ten episodes so far, you can hear from a multitude of people who are deeply involved with the issue, from police captains and sheriffs to former inmates and defense lawyers, as well as a number of ordinary citizens doing remarkable work (like MIWG) to address the inadequacies and injustices they see in the system. The Criminal Justice Reform series airs on the Public channel throughout the week.

In the Tradition is Forever Young
Regular viewers of ACMI's most prolific music show will know that host Alan Kaufman can draw on a large number of excellent musicians who have spent decades of time perfecting their mastery of American traditional idioms. It's important to note, however, that old-time music is not a stagnant genre, but rather continues to evolve and build upon its hearty foundation. Alan's guest for the 26th episode of In the Tradition exemplifies that evolution. Ben Wetherbee is a distinctly young man who comes from a family of fine musicians. Introduced to the violin as a child, Ben has developed into a fine and highly respected fiddler. As a college student, studying abroad in Cork, Ireland, led Ben to immerse himself in Irish traditional music, to which he added Cajun and Bluegrass as well. It's all on display in this rollicking latest episode of In the Tradition, as always to be found on our Public channel.

aCATpella 2018 is a Resounding Success
In August of 2015, Arlington lost a bright young life and beautiful spirit when Catherine Malatesta succumbed to a very rare form of cancer - epithelioid sarcoma - at the age of 16.
