Food Sovereignty in Puerto Rico
It's been a tough few years on the island of Puerto Rico. It narrowly skirted fiscal disaster, but could not escape the full wrath of Hurricanes Irma and Maria. The recovery from both of these continues to proceed at an infuriatingly slow pace. All is not doom and gloom, however, as there are those working in Puerto Rico who recognize the current moment as one of opportunity, and are working hard to ensure a brighter future for the island. One such man is Nelson Alvarez Febles, an agroecologist, food activist and author who is championing the many ongoing efforts to promote food sovereignty, small farms, and agroecology as important strategies for recovery and resilience in the face of future climate disruptions. Our friends in Hardwick, VT, recorded a recent presentation from Nelson on these topics, and have graciously shared the broadcast with us. "Food Sovereignty Solidarity in Puerto Rico" can be seen on our Public channel.

Middlesex DA Candidates' Debate
Do you know who is the most powerful person in the Massachusetts criminal legal system? According to Rahsaan Hall, Director of the Racial Justice Program at the Massachusetts ACLU, it's your local District Attorney, or DA, who makes the decision whether to charge someone with a crime, and if so, whether that crime is one that will carry consequences like a long mandatory prison term or automatic deportation (for immigrants). Despite the extent of their influence and the fact that they are only accountable to voters, DAs often run unopposed in Massachusetts. This year is a little different, and ACMi is happy to have joined the ACLU and the League of Women Voters in presenting a debate between the two Democratic candidates for Middlesex County DA, which took place on Tuesday, July 24 at the First Parish Church in Arlington Center. The event also included a debate between the candidates for Governor's Council, a group with enormous influence over who becomes a judge or Parole Board member in the state of Massachusetts. Both debates are being aired in a two-hour block regularly on both our Public and Government channels. We are very proud to provide this service to Massachusetts voters, and we urge everyone who is eligible to cast their ballots this fall!
